The modern metropolis, as a diverse cosmos, fascinated the pioneers of cinematic art. It was celebrated as a symbol of the new age in such silent classics as «Berlin. Die Sinfonie der Grosstadt» (1927) by Walther Ruttmann and its Brazilian counterpart «São Paulo – A Symphonia da Metr pole» (1929) by Adalberto Kemeny and Rudolf Rex Lustig. The films portray rhythmically pulsating urbanity during the course of an entire day and are particularly characterised by their perfectly compiled and musically accompanied images.

Today's video artists are just as intrigued as those first filmmakers by metropolises. These provide them with large-scale areas of observation, limitless sources of motifs and stage-like settings. The medium of video, with its moving images, soundtrack and editing techniques, seems comparable with film as an ideal means of representing dynamic urban reality. The interest of artists in video grew around the turn of the millennium, when it became more accessible thanks to digital developments and the way in which it permitted them to work in the field. At the same time, rapidly accelerating urbanisation has led to the increasing significance of metropolises around the globe. Today, cities are the most important form of settlement worldwide and it is estimated that well over two-thirds of the global population will be living in urban areas by 2050.

The screening programme contains a rich range of «Urban Stories» from 25 well-known positions, of which 21 come from Switzerland (including many from Zurich) and four from Brazil. With two exceptions, however, the videos are set outside Switzerland: in Europe as well as in the USA, Brazil, South Africa, India and China.

33 videos with a total length of 180 minutes will be shown across two evenings. The dramaturgy of the running order interconnects a wide variety of genres and themes: documentary and conceptual approaches, fiction and film, performance, dance and music clips as well as animation. The subjects include architecture, urban development, public space and the environment, mobility, work and everyday life, social and cultural identity, memory and questions of gender and power.

VIDEO WINDOW is a Zurich-based nomadic platform for contemporary video art curated by Bruno Z'Graggen. It presents video works to a wider audience in the form of screenings, artists' talks and exhibitions and has a special focus on artists who live in Switzerland. 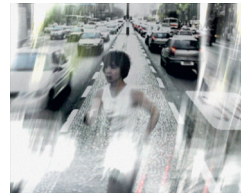
